




## 11th Grade - Community Factors and Student Involvement in Pro-social Activities



\*Three or more hours per week.










# 11th Grade - Sexual Behaviors That Contributed to Unintended Pregnancy and STDs, Including HIV Infection



# 11th Grade - Sexual Risk Behavior Among Students Who Have Ever Had Sex








