




11th Grade - Community Factors and Student Involvement in Pro-social Activities

Used smokeless tobacco before age 13











11th Grade - Sexual Behaviors That Contributed to Unintended Pregnancy and STDs, Including HIV Infection





11th Grade - Sexual Risk Behavior Among Students Who Have Ever Had Sex








