<p>Persons under monitoring module – Melissa – 10 min Last date of exposure is VERY important; please enter this as soon as you interview them, most likely the day before they arrived in the US. This populates the monitoring end date in Orpheus. Drop down – have to click OK to get it to collapse. Have to report plans (EMS and tier II hospital). We need to report this onto CDC. This is good to know in advance of PUMs developing illness. The CDC case unique ID – please enter this number if you have it.</p> <p>What happens when a PUM is transferred from another state? Adding a day – when you pop up – starting on day 10, if you decide you want to go back in time you have to call the Orpheus tech team to populate old fields. We want to track the person when they are in Oregon, not before.</p> <p>Finding cases – not a typical search – you have to uncheck confirmed and presumptive case status, PUMs have different status so unless you uncheck that box you will not find them</p>

ELR updates –Michelle - 30 min:

- Labcorp – they sent an email to all states asking them to ask LHDs to not call LabCorp, before calling them call Michelle so she can troubleshoot.
- Salem Hospital –Sending a list of Signal/cut off ratios. Counties would like to see these in the ELR. Michelle is working with them on this issue.
- OHSU is dual reporting and would like to stop. No issues mentioned, Michelle is going to give approval to stop faxing.
- Sky Lakes – Started ELRs about a month ago, mistakenly sent 400 test messages, turned them off but now have turned back on two weeks ago.
- Willamette Valley. Started ELRs beginning of March, at their 30 day window. No reports of issues with reportable diseases. They are sending non reportable labs which we are filtering out. If you see some come through, you can ignore these.
- Mid Columbia – some concerns that they were sending ELRs without address. This is true for lead patients seen by occupational health, they do not store this – it is coming from the employer so do

If Mid Columbia sends out to Quest, not always getting the Mid Columbia report. Allyson would prefer to get both as Mid Columbia has address. Allyson to send examples to Michelle to help trouble shoot.

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not have address. Would like to discontinue faxing except for lead.

- St Charles – all would like to discontinue faxing – OK to approve?

Karen – Crook county ok with this. Though it is usually a day behind clinician reporting. Heather - Respiratory panels not coming via ELR. Similar issue with gastro panel? Methods not in place for reporting it out yet?

- Kaiser – recent issues with duplicate records, they would like to also discontinue faxing – OK to approve? Clackamas noticing some Kaiser reports are not coming via ELR.
- OSPHL Audit file – duplicates are created, however, don't want to miss reports – OSPHL was sending a weekly audit file to insure that they do not miss a report. They are going to stop sending this audit file to production. Should see less OSPHL duplicates.
- Duplicate reports – algorithm for catching duplicates in ELR – general discussion and feedback.

State sFTP server is getting updated this weekend, hopefully that will be seamless

Peacehealth and addresses – they are upgrading to a new interface in 2016 and are not going to do any development on the old interface.

Contact transfer – any issues - June/all – 5 min

Alejandra – contact record remains on the list as a transfer, have accepted this but does not link. Matt recently fixed a bug that was not marking the transfer as accepted so it remained on the list.

Alejandra – still not able to see the contact associated with the record – the contact id is blank.

Mary – Benton county, clicked on to do list about a contact transfer, cannot see information message. We want to hear about these still. There were some issues that were fixed where the contact was transferred and then the case was changed.

Michelle to see St Charles can send data twice day. Michelle to secure email Karen to get patient name

Send missing Kaiser reports securely to Michelle to resolve issue – if you can not send secure email we can send a secured email that you can respond to.

Let Michelle know if you are still getting duplicates from OSPHL

Let Michelle know if you do not have ELRs by noon on Monday

Please continue to send issues with contact transfers to the Orpheus tech team. We will revisit at the next meeting. Please continue to follow up with another method on contacts that you transfer (phone, secure email, etc)

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To do list and notes – recent issues – June/all – 10 min

Matt rewrote the notes field, made some enhancements and introduced a bug. Note gets made and the check box was checked as done – this was broken so your own notes were showing up on the “to do” list. If you assign the note to a future date, will uncheck the box.

Developer updates- Matt has been working on lead exposure module. Demoed the new screens. Building system so that negative lab results on previous elevated lead cases will be automatically linked. Also doing a Medicaid match to Lead patients. Lots of new information on screening.

Letter creation

There was a bug where you could not see the most recent letter on the list. This bug has been fixed. When the user clicked on the letter it did not go to the correct letter

Highlights from Lyme Disease and Cryptococcus training – June – 5 min

Old case of Lyme disease – if there were reported in another state, make this a no case since it has already been reported and counted. IF you have a case who report an old onset, do not enter this estimated onset (this date is used in reporting). Only enter onset date for acutely ill Lyme cases (recent history of a tick bite).

July 1st – 10:30-11:30 - Coccidioidomycosis

Onset date – do not guess an old onset on Lyme or chronic hepatitis cases. If cases are not acutely ill – do not enter an onset. If they have been previously reported in another state – make them a no case.
