<p><b>Introductions - June - 5 min</b></p> <p><b>ELR updates –Michelle - 10 min:</b>            Columbia Memorial would like to discontinue faxing – no objections and Michelle will give the go ahead.            Willamette Valley just started dual reporting – they will do this for a month.            Sky Lakes sent 600 test messages through to Orpheus. Michelle working to clean these up. They have been removed from Orpheus. Sky Lakes has returned to testing status, once they fix this issue they'll resume dual reporting.            McKenzie-Willamette is close, expect move to dual reporting late March/early April            Blue Mountain, Southern Coos, Lake are actively testing, expect dual reporting in the next two months            Mercy Medical – is testing a new message</p>		

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## **Contact transfer – any issues - Matt/June/all – 10 min**

Matt added the feature that a “To do” message is created when someone rejects your contact transfer, and also if the transfer is accepted. Users can also view contacts from the recent tab. These features were implemented to facilitate finding contacts that were transferred. See the Feb meeting minutes for more information. If a user cannot get a contact transfer off your list, try selecting the list button and then click done box from there. This will remove the name from your contact transfer tab. The same can be used if “to do” lists are not getting cleared with the done check box – click the list button and then choose done.

## **Syphilis reactor records viewable statewide – Irina - 10 min**

The notes are currently being hidden on the basics tab for reactor records, please do not enter any disease information (e.g., , HIV status) in the notes fields for reactors. You can still leave notes with a reactor record but you need to go to the notes tab to do this. The state is going back and sanitizing old reactors to make sure other disease status is not listed.

LHD issues were raised that HIV status should be known to CD staff working up cases. There are cases of NTM, Cryptococcus, etc., that knowing the HIV status would be helpful for the public health workup. CD nurses are trained in confidentiality and should have access to this. For example if a HIV case moved (after was diagnosed in county) the CD nurse might not have access to the HIV record since the person was in another county.

## **First interview attempt field – June – 5 min**

A new field has been added to the basics tab to capture the first interview attempt for enteric cases. These data are often noted in notes but we would like to start capturing time to first attempt at contacting a patient. This is a CDC measure for our Enteric investigations and also will be incorporated into the triennial review reports. If we notice these data in the notes while reviewing the case, we might populate the field. (Especially on older data).

## **Status updating process – June – 5 min**

Status is a very important field when reporting a case so please be sure to populate this. Upon case creation, it is NOT required, but we would like you to populate it. If you are waiting for more information to check and see if it is a case (doctor phone call, etc.), please make it Suspect. Keep in mind that you would need to uncheck the confirmed and presumptive box to find suspect cases using the quick find. Also remember to go back and update this field when you gather more information so our numbers are adequate. State programs review cases and often communicate through Orpheus when the case does not meet a case definition. If we have not heard back from you, we will need to update the status since this flags cases to be reported onto CDC.

## **Cleaning Data – QA**

Reviewed the county review reports and the clean data features in Orpheus. See County Review reports for screen shots on how to run these reports.

Action item – LHDs would like the state program staff to get back to them about asking to follow up on data for cases on a timely basis.
