On April 16, 2014, the Oregon Health Authority, Center for Health Protection, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute ORS 431.950; Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-103-0025, 333-119-0020, 333-119-0140, and 333-124-0010 proposing to impose a civil penalty against **Tan Republic-Newberg** in the amount of **\$3,240.00** for violations of Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) listed in the Notice. The Notice offered **Dexter LaLack & Nic Tyree**, the owner of Tan Republic-Newberg, an opportunity for a hearing, if requested within 20 days of service of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of RPS' file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Dexter LaLack & Nic Tyree, as the record for purposes of default. Dexter LaLack & Nic Tyree did not request a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, after considering the relevant portions of RPS' file relating to this matter, RPS enters the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tan Republic-Newberg consists of a tanning facility at 2115 Portland Road, and has a total of 6 tanning device(s).

2. On January 1, 2014, Tan Republic-Newberg was required to pay to RPS a \$100 registration fee per tanning device, for a total of \$600 in registration fees. OAR 333-119-0020; and 333-103-0025.
3. Two payment notices were mailed to Dexter LaLack & Nic Tyree at the address of record. On November 26, 2013, an Informational Bulletin advising registrants of Electronic Payment to pay outstanding registration fees was mailed to the address of record.
4. To date, RPS has not received any registration fees.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Tan Republic-Newberg did not pay its 2014 registration fees.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Tan Republic-Newberg violated OAR 333-103-0025 by failing to pay its 2014 registration fees.

ORDER

As authorized by ORS 431.950, Tan Republic-Newberg shall pay a civil penalty of **\$3,240.00**, calculated as follows for violations of OAR 333-103-0025 & OAR 333-142-0010(8):

6 devices x \$100 registration fees = \$600


Proposed Civil Penalty Amount: \$3,240.00

1. In addition to paying a civil penalty, Tan Republic-Newberg shall pay the 2014 registration fees of \$600.

Amount Owed to the State: \$3,840.00

2. Failure to comply with this Order may subject Tan Republic-Newberg to further civil penalties.
