## **MILESTONES: in your baby's hearing**

### **Birth to three months...**

- Startles or jumps when there is a sudden loud noise
- Stirs, wakes up or cries when someone talks or makes a noise
- Recognizes your voice and quiets when you speak

### **Birth to six months...**

- Turns eyes towards interesting sounds
- Appears to listen
- Awakes easily to sounds

### **Birth to twelve months...**

- Says first words such as "Da-Da", "Ma Ma" or "Bye-Bye"
