**RULE SUMMARY**

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division is proposing to adopt permanent rules pertaining to the criteria for continuation funding for certified school-based health centers (SBHCs), awarding grants to communities planning for certified SBHCs, and incentive funding to: (1) increase the number of SBHCs as patient-centered primary care homes; (2) improve the coordination of care of patients served by coordinated care organizations and school-based health centers; and (3) improve the effectiveness of the delivery of health services through school-based health centers to children who qualify for medical assistance as mandated by the passage of House Bill 2445 by the 2013 Legislature. The proposed rules are intended to fulfill the mandates by prescribing the criteria for eligibility of funding and grant awards.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.
