

# ALERT IIS Enrollment

The ALERT Immunization Information System (IIS) is Oregon's statewide immunization registry. Developed to achieve complete and timely immunization of all Oregonians throughout their lives, ALERT IIS collects immunization information from public and private health care providers to create complete records for individuals in Oregon. Our goal is to capture every single immunization given in the state of Oregon.

## Getting Started

Identify a Super User for your organization. Super Users serve as your main ALERT IIS clinic contact and will also manage ALERT IIS user access for your site.

They will complete and return your ALERT IIS Authorized Site Agreement to the ALERT IIS Help Desk.
