| Network updates | <p>Mammography Accessibility project: Got funding for an additional three months. Looked at current map of Oregon and identified spots in Oregon where facilities had not been assessed. Next Week Carla will be going to Douglas, Jackson, Curry, and Coos to do assessments. The Grants Pass site has already been assessed. However, this facility will be moving in the fall. The person who was on-site during the assessment is very interested in how to make sure the new site is accessible.</p> <p>OHSU Knight Cancer Institute: Organizing a bio-specimens awareness event in June. This is a 101 event targeted to the general public. This will also be helpful for people working one-on-one with patients.</p> <p>Oregon Public Health: Disability Section is hosting a film festival at the Kennedy School on Saturday, May 12. There is also a brown bag lunch on Thursday, May 10. Carla will send out the information on the listserv. OHSU has two picture books on getting a mammogram intended to explain the process to women with developmental disabilities. It would be useful to have BHTF or Komen print additional books. At the least, put it up on a web page so organizations can print it themselves.</p> <p>BCCP and Comp Cancer are waiting to hear about our upcoming grant years. BCCP is currently only screening symptomatic women. Senate Bill 493, which passed in 2011, pertains to standardizing curriculum for teaching clinical breast exam. BCCP will be making recommendations around this bill.</p> <p>Komen – May 10 is the Grant Luncheon. The Latino Health Equity Conference is coming up on May 17 in Portland. Portland race is a September 16, Sunday. Eugene will also have a race. Sunriver Marathon in September as well.</p> | |
