The original purpose of the Hub was to consolidate the work of data management, technical assistance, and training and contract it to a 3rd party. Laura is in daily licensure negotiation with the Oregon Department of Justice and New York group to finish the final legal review. The next step after this approval will be a project implementation plan supported by New York. The RFP for the Hub did not receive any submissions. OHA plans to continue their work providing technical assistance and for the time being will house the portal.

The CCO and Finance Workgroup has been discussing challenges and barriers to financial sustainability and working with CCOs. They are implementing a speaker's bureau, where local coordinators will discuss their experience with reimbursement and working with CCOs.

The QA, Fidelity, and Metrics Workgroup has worked to identify what elements need to be included in the portal to assure QA and fidelity are being monitored. This group will take a break until October when more progress has been made with the portal.
