<p>In the matter of the registration of:</p> <p>Cascade Medicinal, DBA Front Ave LLC, MMD # 92491</p>	<p>STIPULATED SETTLEMENT ORDER</p>
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1. The Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Medical Marijuana Dispensary Program is responsible for enforcing the law related to the registration of dispensaries. ORS 475.314(10), OAR 333-008-1275.

2. OHA issued a Notice of Proposed Revocation to Cascade Medicinal, MMD # 92491, on May 26, 2015, incorporated by reference.

3. Cascade Medicinal appealed the Notice of Proposed Revocation on May 28, 2015.

4. Cascade Medicinal and OHA desire to settle this matter. Cascade Medical has been fully advised of its rights to notice and a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge the Notice of Proposed Revocation, or this Stipulated Settlement Order, except as provided in paragraphs 5.3.

5. Cascade Medicinal and OHA agree to resolve this matter by entry of this Stipulated Settlement Order, subject to the following conditions:

5.1 Cascade Medicinal shall pay a civil penalty for the following violations in the following amounts for a total civil penalty of \$3,900.00:

- Failure to notify OHA of change, OAR 333-008-1080(1)(d) and (e) – Severity Level (SL) 3: \$300
- Failure to maintain Secretary of State Registration, OAR 333-008-1100 – SL 4: \$200
- Failure to comply with security requirements, OAR 333-008-1140(1) and (5)(b)– SL 1: \$500
- Failure to comply with alarm system requirements, OAR 333-008-1150– SL 1: \$500
- Failure to comply with video surveillance requirements, OAR 333-008-1600 to 333-008-1180 – SL 1: \$500
- Permitting unauthorized on-site consumption, OAR 333-008-1200(1)(b)– SL 1: \$500
- Failure to keep marijuana on-site at the facility and failure to account for inventory, OAR 333-008-1230– SL 1: \$500
- Unauthorized transfer of useable marijuana, OAR 333-008-1245(2)(b) – SL 2: \$400

- Submitting false or misleading information to OHA, OAR 333-008-1260(1)(b) and OAR 333-008-1260(1)(c) – SL 1: \$500

Payment of the civil penalty must be received by OHA within ten days of Cascade Medicinal signing this Order. Payment shall be sent to the Oregon Health Authority, Medical Marijuana Dispensary Program, P.O. Box 14116, Portland, Oregon 97293.

5.2 If Cascade Medicinal, DBA as Front Ave LLC or under any other name, Kevin Clayville or any other PRF operating a dispensary on behalf of Cascade Medicinal, or Ronald Hampton owner of Cascade Medicinal is found, by OHA, to be in violation of any rule classified as a severity level 1 or 2, at any location, Cascade Medicinal agrees that its registration at any and all dispensary locations shall be revoked.

5.3 If OHA determines that Cascade Medicinal or any of the other entities or individuals described in paragraphs 5.2 are in violation of any rule classified as a severity level 1 or 2, as specified in paragraph 5.2, OHA must provide notice of this fact to Cascade Medicinal and explain its right to contest the violations, including the right to a contested case hearing where the only issue will be whether Cascade Medicinal was in violation of a rule identified in the notice. Cascade Medicinal shall have no right to contest the violations in the Proposed Notice of Revocation or the provisions of this Order.

5.4 If, under paragraphs 5.3 Cascade Medicinal does not appeal the notice of violation or OHA prevails in a hearing, Cascade Medicinal agrees that its registration is revoked and neither it, any subsequent owner, nor Kevin Clayville or Ronald Hampton may apply to register a dispensary anywhere in the state for five years from the date of the revocation order, or act as the PRF of any dispensary registered under ORS 475.314.


5.5 The terms of this Order apply to any subsequent owner of Cascade Medicinal.

5.6 Cascade Medicinal agrees that OHA may make this Order public.

5.7 OHA will withdraw the Notice of Proposed Revocation in a separate order once the civil penalty is received.


6. This Order shall remain in effect for one year from the date this Order is signed by OHA.
