Subject: Temporary Laboratory Testing Rules

The Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) would like to remind laboratories that the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has posted temporary rules affecting marijuana testing laboratories. As outlined in OAR 333-008-9000, laboratories wanting to continue to provide testing on marijuana products sold in dispensaries must submit a copy of their quality control manual to the OMMP by **February 29, 2016**. Laboratories that submit manuals will be listed on the OMMP website.

Or may submit electronically to: medmj.dispensaries@state.or.us

On and after March 1, 2016, a dispensary may only accept laboratory test results from a laboratory listed on the program's website.

In addition, laboratories must become accredited by June 1, 2016 in order to provide testing on marijuana products. For information regarding accreditation please visit the Oregon Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program at the following link:
