Subject: Reminder of Public Comment Period for Rules Related to Oregon Medical Marijuana

The Oregon Medical Marijuana Program would like to remind interested parties that it is currently engaged in permanent rulemaking and is accepting public comment until June 3, 2016.

PROPOSED PERMANENT ACTIONS:

Adoption, amendment and repeal of administrative rules in chapter 333, divisions 7, 8 and 64 pertaining to **marijuana labeling, concentration limits and testing; and marijuana growers, processors, dispensaries and patients.**

You are being invited to review and comment on the proposed PERMANENT rules only. **If you wish to present oral testimony, the following public hearings will be held:**
