**Last login is listed – so you know that they are logging in – the active box is also handy on this list – this active user box is maintained and should be up to date. If people see active boxes checked on inactive users – let the tech team know**

**Contact transfer update – still some issues, interface has not been replaced since many fixes –**

**Contact details – what works what doesn't**  
This needs some work – to figure out what works and what does not.

For counties interested in cross jurisdictional data sharing this requires approval of the Overall Responsible Party (ORP). Forms are available online at the Orpheus website.

It was mentioned that some users who have left are still active. There is a list – that tells you last login – which tells you that they are still probably using Orpheus regularly– the account is still active. ORPs need to tell the tech team to deactivate the users.

Let us know if there are still issues – ideally with the case id number

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Please yellow fields on contact detail that must be filled out. Not all of these fields are required – June to follow up with the state STD folks

## Attaching files in Orpheus - have made Orpheus more like it is in outbreaks

This is still problematic with multiple page forms – if this is enteric you can fax it to us – attention Julie, she often adds information before sending onto CDC.

Concern that this goes though the user desktop. This does not need to be saved once you upload to Orpheus. Tom has set it up to download to the temp folder which should get deleted when you log off.
