	<p><b>ELR updates</b> - Legacy recently had a lag in reports, Kaiser still dual reporting but will soon to switch to a new production message by Dec 12. They will then begin dual reporting for a month.</p> <p>Columbia Memorial in Astoria will be sending messages in January, 2015.</p> <p>Mid-Columbia reports – MCMC not sending preliminary results but relying on Quest. Working with them to send finals with results from Quest since they have more complete address info.</p> <p><b>Duplicate ELR button</b> – this is really great to use for when two positive laboratory reports are received in the same ELR and two cases need to be created for the person (ie Gonorrhea/chlamydia, Hepatitis B/C, etc)</p>	<p>Feature request – to add contact duplicate functionality for the STD pathogens when you have dual infections – June to look to see if it is possible now: Yes – you can use the contact duper to duplicate contacts for STD cases. This would apply when you have a dual infection at the same point in time. Contact the tech team if you are interested in this feature.</p>



Once you duplicate the ELR report you can create a new case from the ELR – just as you would the original ELR




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
Once you find the record you want to print redacted – go to the file menu and choose print redacted from the drop down – voila.

**Handling out of state transfers in Orpheus** – When you find out a case that you created is from another state – change the county on the basics tab to ‘out of state’,



- Karen Lewis and the state folks need a note (to do) or a phone call to make sure this happens and she will send these onto the appropriate case.

When you chose the county field the edit address window opens – chose out of state for the county – this is at the bottom of the list



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## Perinatal Hepatitis B

If you know your chronic hepatitis case is now pregnant you add a new fetus to the area in the middle of the basics tab at the bottom

The pregnancy number here needs to be the same as the pregnancy # on the contact tab

There are instructions on the Orpheus website and we are hoping to add a link, from within Orpheus as well

Do not change from status at initial report

NOTE – do not change the pregnancy status on the basic tab unless this is a new pregnant case of chronic hep B. This status should not be updated on newly pregnant chronic Hep b cases.

The key to making your reports run smoothly and be able to track the status of the infants, is to make sure you match the mom to the appropriate pregnancy.

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## Chronic Hepatitis case reporting – date change

Also in terms of chronic hepatitis, there is a feature request to use the LHD report date as the date for counting chronic hepatitis cases. This will be applied retrospectively so historic case counts could change in formal reports. This is being done to add more stability to the data as newly reported cases might have onsets in the past (and the estimated onset has been used for state reporting).

**Letter generation** – How to create your own templates for letters and how to use templates in Orpheus were reviewed. These are available to you for use in case management. These letters are associated with a case. They can be tracked on the more tab for the case.



You can create a letter template in your user settings- these templates already exist and can be applied to your letter. You can apply templates and also modify them for an individual case. We are working on the ability to apply your letter head or logo if that is something that you would want to store electronically. Contact June if you are interested.

You can merge certain fields like name, physician name, etc into the letter to customize it.

You can track when it was sent and if there was any action or response
