Three or four counties reported transferring contacts and there were no issues.

Non *Bordetella pertussis* electronic lab reports – Tila/June – 5 min

For a special project, CDC is asking us to track *Bordetella* species other than pertussis (*holmesii*, *parapertussis* and *bronchiseptica*). Therefore, we will bring these ELR reports into Orpheus starting June X, 2015.

We recommend that reports of *parapertussis*, *holmesii* and *bronchiseptica* infection not be investigated further. However, if one of these species shows in your Orpheus ELR queue, we suggest: creating a pertussis case, making it “No Case” and entering the species in the lab section.

Co-infection: Pertussis + Non-pertussis *Bordetella* Species:

If, through culture and/or PCR testing, it is determined that a case-patient is infected with both *B. pertussis* and another *Bordetella* species (e.g., *B. parapertussis*, *B. holmesii*, *B. bronchiseptica*), assign status of the pertussis case based on the investigative guideline case definition and enter the species in the lab section for each *Bordetella* lab report
