<p>Introductions - June - 5 min</p> <p>Upgrade to FM 14 – success!! Feedback – all -5 min ELR and ALERT issues resolved? Yes seem to be</p> <p>ELR updates –Michelle - 5 min Cerner had a problem where date of birth was one day off. This is a problem for any of the labs using the Cerner system. Applies to Legacy, Kaiser, Adventist, Providence</p> <p>If you notice this on the person record, enter the aka as a date of birth on their person record.</p> <p>Kaiser was asked to stop faxing but people are still going to get faxes. Ok with the state people to stop faxing.</p>	<p>Jeff to double check on Peace Health and whether they need to fax and send ELR</p>	

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Review of ELRs – hard to interpret lab reports – all – 10 min

Two issues – the ELR is not clear or out of order. Test type reactive but unsure which of the hepatitis results was positive. Syphilis labs often come in oddly. Washington county getting multiple faxes from Peace health. Same information.

ALERT Query updates – Michelle – 5 min

Additional fields are now coming into Orpheus from Alert- they are listed in the extra tab – manufacture and lot number.

User reported that if there is no one in Alert then it just queries but does not say that it is found. Found match - populating with data from Alert but there was no data. Kirk reported that if you hit the button more than once it keeps getting more and more. If the only box that is checked is the alert box – it should only import new ones. If any other box is checked it does not delete vaccine records.

PCR tests, CIDT – overview – Julie/Alyssa – 10 min

Julie presented a chart about pcr test results, this will be sent out via HAN. For certain diseases a pcr positive test would classify this as a confirmed case, other diseases it does not work that way. Julie created a chart – for campy cases that are pcr positive these would be a presumptive case, for other enterics (Salmonella, Shigella, STEC) pcr positive tests would be suspect cases and the lab is supposed to do a reflux culture, once the isolate grows the status would need to be updated to confirmed. If the reflux is negative or was not done, it remains a suspect case.

Crypto and Giardia by pcr are confirmed cases.

Julie checks the OSPHL for results twice a day. If these results indicate it is a confirmed case she will update the labs and also the status. She will also send you a note in Orpheus if the result is negative. Different laboratories are running different pcr tests and this can be confusing.

User to send the Alert name to Michelle – it should time out

Just tested and seemed that this was not working as designed. Double check this

Generally you can call the on call epi if you have questions about test interpretation. You can call Tasha for hepatitis or Julie Hatch for Enteric pathogen lab results

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Use the “to do” list to communicate with epis around a case, most people are using there to do list in Orpheus. You can even set yourself a “to do” for the future. You can also go to the more tab – log and see if the person you wanted to communicate with has looked at the record.

Contact transfer – any issues - June/all – 5 min

Debbie reported a recent one. Chris in WA county. You can share the case information with the other county – you do this by adding the county to the more tab. Either someone at the state could do this or the county of the case can also do this. You lose the ability to see a contact once you transferred it to the other county.

Reporting and exporting data - review – June – 10 min

June demoed some of the more common reports, how to use the advanced check box.
