On January 10, 2012, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute ORS 431.950; Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-119-0020 and 333-124-0010 proposing to impose a civil penalty against Salon Shirron in the amount of **\$400** for violations of Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) listed in the Notice. The Notice offered Mary Garcia, an opportunity for hearing, if requested within 20 days of service of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of RPS' file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Ms. Garcia, as the record for purposes of default. Ms. Garcia did not request a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, after considering the relevant portions of RPS' file relating to this matter, RPS enters the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Salon Shirron consists of a tanning facility at, 912 SW Dorion Ave, Pendleton, and has a total of 3 tanning devices.
2. On May 17, 2011, Salon Shirron was inspected by an RPS staff member. During the inspection, Salon Shirron was found to be in violation of a number of administrative rules governing tanning devices and facilities. The violations were cited in the inspection report form dated May 17, 2011, that is incorporated by reference.

3. Salon Shirron or a member of its staff was instructed to respond in writing within 30 days of the inspection with corrective action.
4. Salon Shirron or a member of its staff was informed that if no response was received within 30 days, civil penalties would be assessed as authorized by ORS 431.950 and OAR 333-124-0010.
5. To date, RPS has not received an adequate response to the inspection.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Salon Shirron is operating as a tanning facility in violation of ORS 431.940 and OAR 333, Divisions 119 and 124.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. Salon Shirron violated rules governing tanning facilities as documented in the May 17, 2011 Inspection Report which has been incorporated by reference, has not corrected such violations, and is subject to civil penalties.
2. Pursuant to ORS 431.950 and OAR 333-124-0010, a civil penalty shall be imposed against Salon Shirron totaling **\$400**.
3. The civil penalties are calculated as follows for violations of OAR 333-119:

Proposed civil penalty amount = **\$400**

4. Failure to comply with this Order may subject Salon Shirron, to further civil penalties.

ORDER

Salon Shirron is ordered to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$400.
