On July 12, 2011, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 431.950; Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-103-0025, 333-119-0020, 333-119-0140, and 333-124-0010 proposing to impose a civil penalty against Country Cuttin Salon in the amount of **\$480** for violations of OAR listed in the Notice. The Notice offered Ms. Jennifer Piper, the owner of Country Cuttin Salon, an opportunity for hearing if requested within 20 days of service of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of RPS file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Ms. Jennifer Piper, as the record for purposes of default. Ms. Jennifer Piper did not request a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, after considering the relevant portions of RPS file relating to this matter, RPS enters the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Country Cuttin Salon consists of tanning facility at 29441 Ellensburg Hwy, Gold Beach and has a total of 2 tanning devices.
2. On January 1, 2011, Country Cuttin Salon was required to pay RPS a \$100 registration fee per tanning device, for a total of \$200 in registration fees. OAR 333-119-0020; 333-103-0025.

3. Ms. Jennifer Piper was sent, to her address of record, two payment notices regarding unpaid registration fees. In addition, the Department of Justice (DOJ) sent Ms. Jennifer Piper a letter advising her of potential civil penalties for failure to pay the outstanding registration fees within 10 days of the dated DOJ letter.
4. To date, RPS has not received any registration fees.

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Country Cuttin Salon has not paid its 2011 registration fees.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Country Cuttin Salon violated OAR 333-103-0025 by failing to pay its 2011 registration fees.

ORDER

As authorized by ORS 431.950, Country Cuttin Salon shall pay a civil penalty of \$480, calculated as follows for violations of OAR 333-103-0025:

2 devices x \$100 registration fees = \$200

Proposed Civil Penalty Amount: **\$480**

1. In addition to paying a civil penalty, Country Cuttin Salon shall pay the 2011 registration fees of \$200.
2. Failure to comply with this Order may subject Country Cuttin Salon to further civil penalties.
