The Oregon Health Authority, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) is charged with protecting the health and safety of all Oregonians from unnecessary radiation exposure. It is essential that all registrants comply with Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) relating to tanning facility operations which minimizes health risks to workers, clients, and the public.

On September 27, 2012, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute ORS 431.950; Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 333-119-0020 and 333-124-0010 proposing to impose a civil penalty against Caribbean Sun in the amount of **\$325** for violations of Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) listed in the Notice. The Notice offered Daniel Caldwell, an opportunity for hearing, if requested within 20 days of service of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of RPS' file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Daniel Caldwell, as the record for purposes of default. Daniel Caldwell did not request a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, after considering the relevant portions of RPS' file relating to this matter, RPS enters the following Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Caribbean Sun consists of a tanning facility at 4436 Main Street, Springfield, and has a total of 4 tanning devices.
2. On August 14, 2012, Caribbean Sun was inspected by an RPS staff member. During the inspection, Caribbean Sun was found to be in violation of a number of administrative rules

governing tanning devices and facilities. The violations were cited in the inspection report form dated August 14, 2012, that is incorporated by reference.

3. Caribbean Sun or a member of its staff was instructed to respond in writing within 30 days of the inspection with corrective action.
4. Caribbean Sun or a member of its staff was informed that if no response was received within 30 days civil penalties would be assessed as authorized by ORS 431.950 and OAR 333-124-0010.

### ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Caribbean Sun is operating as a tanning facility in violation of ORS 431.940 and OAR 333, Divisions 119 and 124.

### CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. Caribbean Sun violated rules governing tanning facilities as documented in the August 14, 2012 Inspection Report which has been incorporated by reference, has not corrected such violations, and is subject to civil penalties.
2. Pursuant to ORS 431.950 and OAR 333-124-0010, a civil penalty shall be imposed against Caribbean Sun totaling **\$325**.
3. The civil penalties are calculated as follows for violations of OAR 333-119:

333-119-0100(18)	3	\$100	x 1	= \$100


Proposed civil penalty amount = **\$325**

4. Failure to comply with this Order may subject Caribbean Sun to further civil penalties.

ORDER

Caribbean Sun is ordered to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$325.
