On April 14, 2014, the Oregon Health Authority, Center for Health Protection, Radiation Protection Services (RPS) issued a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute ORS 431.950; Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR)333-103-0025, 333-119-0020, 333-119-0140, and 333-124-0010 proposing to impose a civil penalty against **Video Revelations** in the amount of **\$1,620.00** for violations of Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) listed in the Notice. The Notice offered **Angelique Lewis**, the owner of Video Revelations, an opportunity for a hearing, if requested within 20 days of service of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of RPS' file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Angelique Lewis, as the record for purposes of default. Angelique Lewis did not request a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, after considering the relevant portions of RPS' file relating to this matter, RPS enters the following Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Video Revelations consists of a tanning facility at 665 Ivy Street, and has a total of 3 tanning device(s).

2. On January 1, 2014, Video Revelations was required to pay to RPS a \$100 registration fee per tanning device, for a total of \$300 in registration fees. OAR 333-119-0020; and 333-103-0025.
3. Two payment notices were mailed to Angelique Lewis at the address of record. On November 26, 2013, an Informational Bulletin advising registrants of Electronic Payment to pay outstanding registration fees was mailed to the address of record.
4. To date, RPS has not received any registration fees.

### ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Video Revelations did not pay its 2014 registration fees.

### CONCLUSION OF LAW

Video Revelations violated OAR 333-103-0025 by failing to pay its 2014 registration fees.

### ORDER

As authorized by ORS 431.950, Video Revelations shall pay a civil penalty of **\$1,620.00**, calculated as follows for violations of OAR 333-103-0025 & OAR 333-142-0010(8):

**3 devices x \$100 registration fees = \$300**

**Proposed Civil Penalty Amount: \$1,620.00**

1. In addition to paying a civil penalty, Video Revelations shall pay the 2014 registration fees of \$300.

**Amount Owed to the State: \$1,920.00**

2. Failure to comply with this Order may subject Video Revelations to further civil penalties.
