


How Pregnancy Occurs



Each month during ovulation, an egg is released (1) and moves into one of the fallopian tubes. If a woman has sex around this time, and if the egg and sperm meet in the fallopian tube (2), the two may join. If they join (3), the fertilized egg begins dividing as it moves through the fallopian tube into the uterus (4), where it becomes attached to the uterine lining to grow during pregnancy.
