Agencies who qualify for purchasing family planning supplies through HRSA's 340B program must participate in the annual recertification for Title X clinics. Recertification will run from May 11 to June 8, 2016.

To ensure a smooth recertification, visit the [340B program database](#) and verify that your agency's information is current, especially the 340B Authorizing Official and Primary Contact information. The Authorizing Official will be responsible for completing the recertification process on-line. Webinar: Integrating Community Health Workers (CHWs) Into Your Practice **(April 27, 8:00-9:00)**

Community Health Workers (CHWs) have increasingly become a bigger participant in improving patient outcomes. They focus on providing assistance to community members in settings and ways that are most comfortable to the community member (e.g. a home visit, the library, in a coffee shop, etc.). They also provide expertise in offering equitable and culturally responsive access to information and services for historically disenfranchised populations and individuals. Yet, integrating CHWs into a busy practice can have its challenges.
