# Legislation from the Network

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- SB436 “KidsLink”: CCOs maximize use of SBHCs and integrates care with other relevant programs (e.g. Healthy Start, relief nurseries, CAWEM, local public health, etc.).
- Permanent funding for SBHCs; Expansion of service dollars to work towards parity of payment and increased services
