What were the major changes?

- SBHCs in state statute (certification & funding)
- Increased funding for SBHC system (HB2445)
 - Funding for new SBHCs
 - Improved funding formula parity
 - Staff for State Program Office
 - Funding for additional technical assistance
 - Incentive grants to support SBHC integration into CCOs
- New funding partnership with the Addictions & Mental Health Division (AMD)
 - Expanded MH provider FTE in SBHCs
 - Funded quality improvement special projects
 - Funded MH project coordinator








New Investments

Total new funds = \$ 4.8M



Updates from HB2445

- Amended ORS 413.225 to include definition of SBHC
 - Language should be updated later this year.
- Rules:
 - Certification: Procedures and criteria for the certification, suspension and decertification of school-based health centers
 - OARs 333-028-0200 to 333-028-0250 **ADOPTED**
 - Funding: criteria for **continuation** funding for certified school-based health centers (SBHCs), awarding grants to communities **planning** for certified SBHCs, and **incentive funding** to: (1) increase the number of SBHCs as patient-centered primary care homes; (2) improve the coordination of the care of patients service by coordination care organizations and school-based health centers; and (3) improve the effectiveness of the delivery of health services through school-based health centers to children who qualify for medical assistance– **IN PROCESS**

HB2445 Workgroup

- Workgroup's goal was to develop recommendations for:
 - Optimizing the effective and efficient use of SBHCs by CCOs, including effective coordination of care and reimbursement;
 - Ensuring the coordination and disclosure of protected health information by SBHCs in accordance with ORS 414.679 and
 - Developing financial incentives to:
 - Increase the number of SBHCs certified as patient centered primary care homes (PCPCH) without requiring SBHCs to be certified as patient centered primary care homes;
 - Improve the coordination of the care of patients served by CCOs and SBHCs; and
 - Improve the effectiveness of the delivery of health services through SBHCs to children who qualify for medical assistance.
- Three meetings (Sept/Oct/Nov)
- Report submitted to Legislature before 12/31/13.

Updates from HB2445

- Training and Technical Assistance Contract
Oregon School-Based Health Alliance
 - Assist SBHCs in expanding their relationships with CCOs, medical sponsors, and community-based providers
 - Assist SBHCs in improving business practices, including practices related to billing and efficiencies.
 - Facilitate the integration of health and education policies and programs at the local level so that SBHC operate in an optimal environment



SBHC Mental Health Expansion Funding

- \$4.6 million available via Addictions and Mental Health (AMH) to increase SBHC mental health capacity
- Grants to support:
 - Add/expand mental health staffing
 - Mental health projects: screening, Telehealth, data integration, YAC, cultural competency
- **16** counties requested funding, **16** awarded

Key Performance Measures

- Health Assessments
- Complete Physical Exams
 - Combining the health assessment with the well child/CPE
 - Getting CPE records from the client's PCP 'counts'
 - Count CPEs back one *calendar* year from the date you are seeing the student
 - 3 documented attempts to obtain records from a client's PCP *or* 3 documented attempts offering a CPE with client/parent refusal (these charts would be removed from the audit, reducing the total number of charts).



Standards for Certification

- The new Standards for Certification apply to all verification site visits effective immediately
- The new standards are available on our certification web page:
www.healthoregon.org/sbhc
- The certification web page has been updated to reflect new standards, please be sure to bookmark them!

Standards for Certification changes to be aware of

- There is a revised list of policies and procedures; we will be providing you with a new certification binder soon
- Having a *system* in place to assure clients have *access to their records*, are able to *renew prescriptions*, and *respond to client clinical questions when a provider is not available*

Service Changes

- Dental (EFDA/DMD) service hours on site count toward the additional 10 hours/week = 20 minimum.
- HIV: Updated 2014 Standards for Certification of SBHCs require HIV testing to be available *on site* in SBHCs located in middle, high school and combined grade (K-8, K-12) campuses.

- Targeted risk assessment vs. routine screening
- Consent considerations
- Lab testing methods

In the coming school year, our goal is to have each site complete their profile by October 1st, 2014.



Common Operational Profile Issues

- Checking the accuracy confirmation box
 - Details, Operations, Individual Staff records (both staff info and shift hours)



This information is accurate
Confirmed by

- Incomplete and inaccurate staff information
 - Staff information needs to be updated from the individual staff records, not the main Staff and Shift Hours summary pages
 - Click on the 'To Staff' button to reach individual staff records
- KPMs – All percentages should be under or at 100%
 - If it's over 100% the information is incorrect
