# 2011-2013 SBHC State Program Budget


- 2011 Legislative Session reduced the SBHC General Fund (GF) by \$500K
- Backfilled the \$500K reduction using new revenue (Public Health)
- General Funds (GF) = \$5,123,718
- Other Funds (OF) = \$1,380,000 (Provider Tax)
- = \$ 500,000 (PHD Revenue)
- Total funds = \$7,003,718
- Short session reductions were NOT taken
  - No other reductions planned at this point
- Staffing update
  - SBHC Manager, Epidemiologist

- Establish a 2012 workgroup to review SBHC policies
  - SPO, MCH-CLHO, Network, Site Representation
  - Workgroup will meet in May/June
  - Policy revisions & timelines in July
- Alignment with Patient-Centered Primary Care Home Standards


# PHD's Organizational Structure

- Patient Satisfaction Survey
  - All selected sites must complete at least 30 surveys (some will complete more)
  - Helps sites to meet the Patient-Center Primary Care Home Standards
  - Administration timeframe: October 1<sup>st</sup> through June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Profile/Staffing/KPM/Financial Data Updates
  - New web-based form
    - Previously entered data will be visible
    - Update and/or add information
    - Required to review all information for each of your staff and confirm accuracy
    - One login will be assigned to each SBHC system
  - Still due October 1<sup>st</sup> (link will be sent out September 1<sup>st</sup>)
