

Summary of Relevant Bills Passed in 2015 Session: SBHC Coordinator's Meeting

January 20th, 2016

Below is a summary of bills relevant to SBHCs, or school health generally, that were passed during the 2015 Oregon Legislative Session. The list is not all-encompassing of every piece of legislation related to the adolescent population. The bill number, brief summary, and link to additional details and bill text are provided.

SB 698: Creates position of State School Nurse Consultant in OHA and establishes Task Force of School Nursing. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/SB698>

HB 2758: Prohibits carriers or 3rd party administrators from disclosing to person other than the enrollee who receives health services, protected health information related to services provided to the enrollee. Requires carrier and third party administrator to adopt procedures for enrollee to request to have protected health information protected from disclosure to policyholder or certificate holder and redirected to enrollee. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/HB2758>

HB 2879: Permits pharmacists to prescribe hormonal contraceptive patches and self-administered oral hormonal contraceptives. Requires evidence of previous prescription from primary care practitioner or women's health care practitioner for hormonal contraceptive patch or self-administered oral hormonal contraceptive for person who is under 18 years of age (until January 2020). <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/HB2879>

HB 3343: Requires insurers to cover prescription contraceptives for a: three-month period for the first dispensing; and twelve-month period for subsequent dispensings of the same contraceptive. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/HB3343>

HB 5005: Amounts authorized for issuance of general obligation bonds of the state during the 2015-2017 biennium. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/HB5005>

SB 895: Requires schools and children's facilities to make available certain information related to immunizations. Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to include certain information related to immunizations on school district and school performance reports. Makes certain provisions relating to immunization apply to all children attending school or children's facility during or after 2015-2016 school year. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/SB895>

SB 856: Establishes child sexual abuse prevention instructional program for public schools. <https://olis.leg.state.or.us/liz/2015R1/Measures/Overview/SB856>

HB 2307: Prohibits mental/social health service professionals to provide any service to a minor for the purpose of attempting to change their sexual orientation or gender identity.

HB 3100: Changes governmental framework for conducting public health activities in this state and for providing public health services to residents of this state.
