





Perinatal hepatitis B case management activities in Oregon, 1994-2013 birth cohorts. Shown is the number of infants enrolled in case management and the percent of those infants meeting the indicators of successful case management.



Notes:

- *Treated within one day* – received both the first dose of the hepatitis B birth dose and Hepatitis B Immune Globulin (HBIG) within one calendar day of birth
- *PVST* – post-vaccination serologic testing
- Due to changes in the reporting requirements over time, some years display the percent of infants completing the hepatitis B vaccine series by 12 months and some display the percent completing the series by 15 months of age.
