

Instructions for Immunization Primary Review Summary Page 4 — Section H

Follow-up statistical report for all students enrolled at your school in grades K-12

This page tells us the final status of all of the students in your school or program in grades K – 12 after all records have been updated. If your school has PreK students, those children will be reported in Section E. Do not include PreK students in Section H. Please complete this page after the records of all students needing updates have been updated or by 12 days after exclusion day (even if students are still excluded), whichever comes first.

Count all students who are enrolled in any grade, K-12, that attend your school. This report needs to be complete even if you have already completed sections F or G. If students have left your school since you turned in the initial report, do not count them in this follow-up report. If children have enrolled in your school since the initial report, do not count them. These students will be counted in the next review cycle.

- Total enrollment: This is the total number of students enrolled in your school/program in grades K-12.
- Students not counted: Students who are enrolled at your site but attend classes elsewhere should not be included in this report.
- Adjusted enrollment: This is the total enrollment, minus the students not counted.
- DTaP/Tdap, Polio, Varicella, MMR, Measles, Hep B:
Fill in the number of students who are complete for that vaccine.
- Number of students in K– 8th grade: Fill in the number of students in grades K-8. This is the number of students required to have the Hepatitis A vaccine in school year 2016-2017.
- Number of students in K– 8th grade who are complete for Hep A vaccine:
Fill in the number of students in grades K-8 who are complete for Hepatitis A vaccine.
- Number of students with all the vaccines required for their grade:
Fill in the number of students that are complete for all of the vaccines required at their grade level. Include students with history of disease or immunity documentation. Students with exemptions will not be counted in this number.
- No record: Students who have no immunization records or exemptions on file should be counted here. If all of the records have been updated, this number should be zero.
- Medical exemptions: A student that has a temporary or permanent medical exemption should be counted here.
- Nonmedical exemptions: Any student that has a nonmedical exemption, whether for one or all vaccines, should be counted here.
- How many nonmedical exemptions are from:
Fill in the number of students with a nonmedical exemption that have documentation from the following two categories: the online vaccine education module or a health care practitioner.
- Nonmedical exemptions by vaccine: Fill in the number of students who have a nonmedical exemption for each of the vaccines listed on the form. If a student has a nonmedical exemption for every vaccine, count them in each of the individual vaccine categories. For Hepatitis A, only count students with a nonmedical exemption for Hepatitis A vaccine who are in grades K-8.
- Number of students with a nonmedical exemption for **all** the vaccines required for their grade:
Fill in the number of students who have nonmedical exemptions for every vaccine required for their grade.

Once you have completed Section H, tear off the back (yellow) copy of the form. This information is also for your records, and must be kept for one year. The top (white) copy of this form along with the copies of the other reporting forms need to be turned in to the health department by 12 days after Exclusion Day. The information can be used to calculate the immunization and exemption rates by vaccine at your school. The number of students complete divided by the number of students required to have the vaccine equals percent vaccinated.
