

Emergency Medical Technician Intermediate (EMT-I)

A person must have an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT) license before being eligible to enroll in the EMT-I course. Oregon EMT-I education is provided through the use of the Oregon Health Authority EMS Section EMT-I course curriculum.

Clinical experience performed under the supervision of a preceptor of at least eight (8) hours and twenty (20) patient contacts in a hospital emergency department or medical clinic where the skills with an EMT-I of scope of practice are performed under the supervision of a preceptor.

Satisfactory completion of at least eight (8) hours prehospital experience under the supervision of an EMT-I or above where the skills within the scope of practice of an EMT-I are performed.
