Quality

Goal: Promote a culture of continuous improvement in the public health system.

Activities:

- Provide technical assistance to the public health system to improve services.
- Support use of data to inform public health decision making.

Performance

Goal: Enhance public health practice to improve system capacity.

Activities:

- Fund accreditation readiness projects at local public health departments.
- Develop and disseminate tool(s) to access, analyze and display data.

Partnerships

Goal: Strengthen public health system partnerships and the public's understanding of the importance of public health.

Activities:

- Advance public health system collaboration
- Build cross-jurisdictional collaboration between public health and emerging partners (e.g. land use planning, transportation, family violence prevention).
